International Day of Family Remittances



The **GFRID Summit 2023** will take place in the context of the **International Day of Family Remittances (IDFR)**, a universally-recognized observance adopted by the United Nations
General Assembly (Resolution A/RES/72/281) and marked every year on 16 June. The day recognizes the contribution of over 200 million migrants, who send remittances home to 800 million family members.

This year, the IDFR will be observed on the last day of the GFRID Summit, 16 June, at the United Nations Office at Nairobi. Through this observance, the UN aims to raise greater awareness about the impact that remittances have on millions of households, entire communities and countries.
