International Day of Family Remittances

The official observance ceremony of the International Day of Family Remittances will see the presence of high-level representatives from IFAD, UN OSAA, the World Bank Group, and the Ministry of Foreign and Diaspora Affairs of the Republic of Kenya.

Session 1 will focus on 'Migrant and diaspora contributions: rescuing champions towards the achievement of SDGs by 2030'

Main discussion points:

- Realities of the SDGs in 2023
- Remittance families and SDGs
- Migrants and diasporas: beneficiaries, investors or partners?

The two following sessions are dedicated to two of the twenty-three <u>Global</u> <u>Compact for Migration</u> (GCM) Objectives, related to migrants' contribution to development and reducing remittance costs.

- Global Compact objective 19: Create conditions for migrants and diasporas to fully contribute to sustainable development in all countries
- Global Compact objective 20: Promote faster and cheaper transfer of remittances and foster financial inclusion of migrants

These sessions will be followed by the <u>IDFR 2023 Recognition</u> and the Private Sector <u>RemTECH Awards 2023.</u>
